MISSING PERSON: Brian Richard Bleyl, white male, 12 years old at time of disappearance, 4' 11" tall, 100 pounds, with brown eyes, and blonde. Brian is diabetic and requires insulin.

CLOTHING: Blue gym shirt and dark blue gym type pants.

DATE MISSING: February 28, 1981 at approximately 3:00 P.M.

NARRATIVE: On February 28, 1981 at approximately 3:00 P.M., Brian Bleyl was last seen in the area of North 9th Avenue and West Myrtle Avenue as he left on his bicycle to complete his newspaper route. In 1989 a man was charged with Brian's abduction and murder, despite the fact Brian's body was never recovered. This man was acquitted in a jury trial of the charges and subsequently died in 1994, still denying he had anything to do with Brian's disappearance. Brian is believed to be a victim of foul play but his body has never been recovered. His dental records and DNA profile are on file.
