Phoenix SERIOUS INJURY COLLISION

On March 24, 2021, at about 7:33 a.m., officers responded to the area of 8600 West Thomas Road for a serious injury traffic collision involving a passenger car and an armored vehicle. Detectives responded and learned the following; A 2007 Cadillac, driven by a 29-year old male was traveling westbound on Thomas Road at a high rate of speed when he lost control and crossed into eastbound traffic colliding with an armored truck operated by a 28-year-old male.

Phoenix Fire personnel responded and transported the 29-year-old male and his two passengers, an 11-year-old female and 5-year-old female to a nearby hospital in critical condition. The driver displayed signs of impairment.

The driver and occupant of the armored vehicle were not seriously injured and remained on scene. The driver of the armored vehicle was evaluated for signs of impairment and none were found.

Charge are pending further investigation.
