Juvenile Kidnapped After Home Invasion

(December 20, 2022): Detectives are investigating a home invasion that resulted in the kidnapping of a 17-year-old male and the shooting of an adult male.

Phoenix police officers were dispatched to an unknown trouble call at a home near 88th Avenue and Indian School Road. When officers arrived, they learned two men forced their way into the home and shot a man who was asleep inside. The men then kidnapped 17-year-old Jesse Camacho from inside the home and drove off in a dark colored sedan.

The man with the gunshot wound was transported to the hospital with non-life-threatening injuries.

Detectives responded and processed the scene, interviewed witnesses, and collected surveillance video. The investigation is continuing as detectives are actively following leads.

There have been no arrests made and Camacho remains missing. We ask anyone with information to contact the Phoenix Police Department or Silent Witness if they wish to remain anonymous.
