An Overnight Stabbing Leaves a Man in Critical Condition

(February 4, 2023) Phoenix police detectives are investigating a stabbing that happened overnight in the area of 36th Street and Thomas Road which left one man in critical condition.

On February 4, 2023, just before 12:30 a.m. Phoenix police officers responded to a stabbing near 2600 North 36th Street. When units arrived, they found a man with stab wounds. The victim was transported to a local hospital where he continues to receive treatment for life threatening injuries. The suspect in the case, identified as Reginald Malone, was arrested as he ran from the location.

Homicide detectives responded to investigate the stabbing. Preliminary information indicates that a fight occurred between the victim and Reginald. During this fight, Reginald stabbed the victim and then took off from the location. He was located nearby and arrested. In the subsequent interview, Reginald admitted to his involvement in the incident. Reginald was booked into jail on charges of aggravated assault.
