The suspect in this case has been identified as 39-year-old Leroy Malone. The Kansas Bureau of Investigations had confirmed Malone was involved in an officer involved shooting with Clark County deputies in Minneola, Kansas where he was shot and killed. The Phoenix homicide investigation remains active as detectives continue towards completing the investigation.

Suspect in Phoenix Double Homicide Involved in Shootout with Kansas Authorities

(January 23, 2023) Phoenix police detectives are investigating a double homicide that happened this weekend in the area of 51st Avenue and Warner Street.

On January 22, 2023, just after 1:00 p.m. Phoenix police officers responded to an injured person call near 5100 West Warner Street. When officers arrived, they located two adults who had been fatally shot. The victims were identified as 28-year-old Cameron Brown and 27-year-old Asya Ribble. Their two small children were located inside the house unharmed and uninjured.

Homicide detectives responded to investigate the incident. As the investigation progressed detectives identified an adult male as a suspect. It was also learned that an adult female was likely with the suspect. The man and woman were tracked out of the state. Phoenix detectives contacted agencies nationwide, with information about the man and woman along with the case explanation.

Deputies from the Clark County Sheriff's Office located the man and woman near Minneola, Kansas based on the information disseminated by Phoenix police. A confrontation occurred between law enforcement and the male suspect, resulting in an officer involved shooting.
