This incident occurred at a local business that was being used to host a party. During the event two individuals got into an argument that led to the shooting. Six of the nine victims ages have been updated above. All victims' injuries are a result of gunshot wounds and are non-life-threatening.

## Detectives Seek Suspect in Shooting That Left 9 Injured

(December 31, 2022) Phoenix police detectives are investigating what led up to an early Saturday morning shooting that left nine victims injured.

Officers responded to several 911 calls of a shooting just after 4:00 a.m. on December 31, 2022. When officer arrived at a local business in the area of 4200 North 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue, they encountered several victims who suffered from gunshot wounds. Phoenix Fire Department responded and took a number of victims to a local hospital with serious, but non-life-threatening injuries.

Several other victims were taken to nearby hospitals prior to police arrival and have since been contacted by Police. A total of nine victims in the shooting have been identified at this time, but detectives believe there may be other outstanding victims.

One notable victim has been identified as an adult female who is pregnant. Her injuries have not affected the pregnancy and are non-life threatening.

Information regarding the events that led to the shooting are still on-going as detectives work to understand what led up to this incident and identify any, and all, involved suspect. Anyone with
