## **Juvenile Killed in Hit and Run**

(February 11, 2023) Phoenix police detectives are investigating a fatal hit and run collision that happened in the area of 67<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Thomas Road just after 5 p.m. Saturday.

Phoenix police responded to a collision between a juvenile pedestrian and a lifted truck on Saturday February 11, 2023, in the area are 67<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Thomas Road. When officers got to the scene, they saw the juvenile pedestrian laying in the roadway suffering critical injuries. Phoenix Fire responded and took the victim to the local hospital where he later succumbed to his injuries.

Detectives responded to take over the investigation and learned that the suspect was driving northbound on 67<sup>th</sup> Avenue when it struck the victim who reportedly stepped off the sidewalk into the street. The suspect vehicle was last seen driving north on 67<sup>th</sup> Avenue away from the scene and is described as a 4-door lifted maroon or faded red colored truck with chrome strip across the door.
