On May 29, 2018, at 1417 hours, Phoenix Police Officers responded to a call of a subject with a gun at the Transit Station at 9400 N. Metro Parkway West. The call indicated the subject was manipulating a handgun while he was on one of the benches at the station. A live handgun round was later found on the ground near where this occurred.

When the first officers, a sergeant and an officer arrived on scene, a security guard directed them to a bus, which was starting to leave the station and said the suspect was on the bus. They stopped the bus and entered the front door, at which time the security guard pointed to the suspect, seated on the rear seat of the bus and identified him as the suspect in question. There were a number of other passengers on the bus. The sergeant gave commands for him to not touch the gun. The suspect ignored the commands and produced a handgun from his pocket. The sergeant and the officer fired at and struck the suspect, ending the threat. The officers administered first aid, however, the suspect was pronounced deceased on scene. There were no injuries to officers.
