

**MEDIA ADVISORY**  
**AGGRAVATED ASSAULT ON POLICE**  
**OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTING**

**Details:** On Thursday, February 1, 2018, at around 2:30pm, Phoenix Police responded to a residential burglary in progress located near 8800 West Kingman Street. The caller described two males who appeared to be in their teens removing items from the home. Officers arrived and located an unoccupied gray Honda parked in front of the victim house with the engine running. As the officers walked through the open side gate toward the backyard, they confronted a 15 year old suspect. One officer gave orders to the suspect who then presented a handgun. The officer fired his service weapon, but did not strike the suspect. The suspect immediately dropped his weapon and surrendered. He was taken into custody without incident.

The second suspect, a 17 year old male, exited the front of the house and fled in the waiting vehicle. Responding units located the vehicle and kept it in sight while the Air Unit responded. The driver collided with a truck near 51<sup>st</sup> Avenue and Van Buren Street. Nobody was injured in this collision. The driver then exited the vehicle and surrendered to officers without incident.

Both suspects were detained and will be referred to the Maricopa County Juvenile Correctional Center.
