

Officer Involved Shooting

Date/Time: November 13, 2018 / 1539 hours

Location: 6300 N. 64th Drive, Glendale, Arizona

On Tuesday, November 13, 2018 at approximately 1440 hours, an armed robbery suspect who had committed multiple armed robberies and a carjacking, committed another armed robbery near 32nd Street and Thomas Road. Responding officers saw the suspect vehicle, which had been stolen several days earlier, fleeing the scene and attempted to stop it, but were unsuccessful. A pursuit was initiated until Tactical Support Bureau officers took over and transitioned to a tactical surveillance.

The vehicle was followed to the area of 6300 N. 64th Drive in Glendale, where the suspect vehicle drove into an apartment complex. Attempts were made to contain the vehicle in the complex, but it got back to the street before it could be contained. The suspect came out of his vehicle and raised a Glock handgun, prompting two officers and a sergeant to fire at the suspect, which ended the encounter at approximately 1539 hours. No officers were injured and the suspect was pronounced deceased at the scene.

The Glendale Police Department will be conducting the investigation into the shooting. They will be assisted by the Phoenix Police Department Robbery Unit.
